Wedding Ceremony Agreement & Contract

This Agreement, dated _____, 20____ by and between Kenneth M. Chisholm (hereinafter called "Officiant") and _____(Bride) And _____(Groom). Hereinafter called "Couple" agree as follows:

1. Officiant shall perform a marriage ceremony for the Couple on the _____ day of _____, 20 ____ at _____) (time of day) and at _____(Facility) which is located at _____
2. Officiant warrants that he is duly Licensed and Ordained to perform such ceremonies in the State of Ohio. If the ceremony is performed in a state outside Ohio, Officiant warrants he meets the respective state/county requirements to perform the ceremony.
3. Officiant will provide the following service(s) for a fee of \$_____ under the terms of the Agreement. This fee includes travel to the venue within a ____-mile radius. A Non-Refundable Deposit of \$_____ is due at the signing of this Agreement. Any/all additional services as listed (see "additional services" below) are discretionary to the Couple and must be agreed to and payment is due at the Rehearsal, and if no Rehearsal, prior to the service.
4. Officiant will collaborate with the Couple, as often as necessary in-person, by email, phone, or whichever is mutually most beneficial. Officiant can provide sample services available and the Couple may choose to modify portions of the service, so long as the integrity of the service is not compromised.
5. The Officiant will attend the Rehearsal to lead / assist with various aspects of the Rehearsal such as: procession, placement of Wedding Party etc.

6. Officiant will arrive at the Wedding venue approximately 1 hour prior to the ceremony.
7. In the event the Officiant is unable to perform the Couple's wedding ceremony due to illness, hospitalization, accident, transportation breakdown or other unforeseeable causes, Officiant will make every attempt to notify the Couple and arrange for another ordained minister licensed and qualified to perform weddings in the jurisdiction of the wedding ceremony. In such an event that no substitute is available, all monies paid by the Couple to the Officiant will be returned and the Couple hereby agrees that the Officiant will not be held liable for any damages (including punitive) due to the non-performance of the ceremony or function.
8. Officiant hereby agrees to allow the Couple to use his likeness in any photographs, videos or other recording media in any manner or purpose they wish. Likewise, the Couple also agrees to the officiant allowing the use of pictures or recordings for marketing purposes.
9. In the event additional ceremony components are to be added to the service (i.e., Unity Candle lighting, Hand-Fasting etc.). It is the responsibility of the Couple to purchase and otherwise obtain said components and notify the Officiant in advance of the service to adequately allow for changes/additions.

The Couple will obtain a valid Marriage License from the appropriate jurisdiction for which the ceremony will be performed and will provide said license to the Officiant at or immediately prior to the ceremony. * The Officiant will be unable to perform the ceremony in the absence of a valid Marriage License.

The Officiant will complete, sign, and return the completed license to the County Clerk's office where the License was obtained by the Couple within 30 days of the wedding ceremony, OR unless otherwise directed by the Couple. Furthermore, the Officiant will make and keep a legible copy of the Marriage License for records purposes.

This agreement and any attachments constitute the entire agreement between the parties and may not be modified except in writing signed by both parties. No other representatives or promises have been made except those that are set out in this agreement. If any part of this agreement is adjudged to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the remaining parts shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.
